Wireless Telegraphy Act 1905-1973

AMATEUR STATION LICENCE No. WA681

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authority conferred upon the Minister for Post and Telecommunications by Section 5 of the *Wireless Telegraphy Act 1905-1973*, and the *Wireless Telegraphy Regulations*, a licence is granted to **D.E. FUGH** to establish an AMATEUR radio station at **173 FENDHAM STREET, WARNBRO.** and to operate the said station in accordance with the particulars in the schedule hereto until **27th May, 1977.**

The installation and operation of the said station shall be carried out in accordance with the provisions of the said regulations as amended from time to time during the currency of this licence and shall be subject to such further restrictions and conditions as are from time to time notified by the Minister or by any officer thereto authorised in writing by the Minister.

NOTES:-(1) The Amateur Service is the Secondary Service in this band.

(2) This band allocated on a temporary basis until required by the Broadcasting Service.

(3) This band is designated for Industrial, Scientific and Medical purposes. Radiocommunication services operating within the band must accept any harmful interference that may be experienced from the operation of industrial, scientific or medical equipment.

3. TYPES OF EMISSION AUTHORISED:

All bands	A1, A3, A3A, A3B, A3H, A3J, A4 (± 3kHz), F1, F3 (± 3 kHz), F4 (± 3kHz) and for RTTY-F1, F2 or A2 (International Alphabet No. 2, 5 unit code up to 850 hertz frequency shift).
All bands above 52 MHz	A0, A2, A4 (± 3kHz), F2, F3, F4 (± 8kHz), P0.
Ultra High and Super High Frequency Bands	A5, P1, P2D, P2E, P2F, P3D, P3E, P3F.

4. AUTHORISED TRANSMITTER POWER:

- A3A, A3J-400 watts (Peak envelope output power)
- Pulse-150 watts (Peak envelope input power to final stage x duty cycle)
- Other emissions-150 watts (input power to final stage)
